slow wine – because it's a personal thing.

"In a world that is beginning to become more and more impersonal, we try to slow down a little and enjoy what has always been a personal thing – wine."

Being an old trend that has been discarded by commercial wineries in favor of raising the quantity of production, slow wine returns to the roots of classic winemaking tradition by importing natural wines from small winemakers – passionate artisans that see themselves as non-interventionists and risk-takers.

Who? We, a duo of educated sommeliers and slow enthusiasts, have a mission to rejuvenate our wine culture by collaborating with like-minded winemakers that share our sense for hedonistic pleasure on the basis of few additives and as little manipulation as possible. In sum, unique & exciting flavors, old-style crafted wine beauties and an alternative to today's modern consumerism.

Why? By being more in tune with life's natural rhythm, we aim to embrace ancestral wine culture and working together with producers of local provenances in Italy. Since Italy is at the heart of the slow food movement, a wide range of winemakers have been embracing the philosophical foundation behind the dolce fare slow. With an emphasis on mindfulness about drinking natural and artisanal produced pleasure, these producers shared their personal stories with us, which we would like to share with you. After all, we aspire to act as ambassadors for the local wineries in order to create a bridge between consumers here and producers over there.

What? Just as we like to know what we're eating these days, we want to know exactly what we're drinking, too. Our imported wines are the result of delicate winemaking processes with a minimum of interventions, no additives but only the tiniest quantities of sulphites, and made by independent producers from handpicked and organically grown grapes. Unlike commercially produced wines, our natural wines are not subjected to intense controlled production processes as opposed to the ones employed in big companies. This allows winemakers to create a one-of-a-kind wine with an own personal touch. A wine, which opens up for new exciting experiences.

Reading Guide

You are reading the current price list of slow wine. This list structured around the Italian wine regions in alphabetical order. In every region you find the producers we work together with and their wines we offer. You can see from every wine whether it is a sparkling (mouss.), white, rosato, red or passito (sweet) wine. There is a vat-exclusive and vat-inclusive price for every wine. You can find more detailed information about the regions, producers, wines, grape varieties and availability on www.slow-wine.net.



Ten rules for natural wines

1. The winemaker is a relatively small, independent wine producer.
2. The winemaker wants to produce natural wines out of principals and understands the risks.
3. The winemaker grows his own grapes.
4. The grape varieties being used are mainly local, native grape varieties, autochthonic to the region.
5. The handpicked grapes are cultivated biologically; no chemicals and pesticides.
6. The winemaker follows the natural course in the vinification process.
Nothing is added to correct color, smells or taste of a wine.
7. Sulphites are used as a conservator and in absolute minimal doses.
8. The fermentation starts spontaneous with indigenous yeasts own to the grape.
9. The wine is not clarified and very lightly filtered.
10. The wine is a unique expression of the maker and reflects the terroir with specific cultural context and traditions.

Terms and conditions

1. General

- 1.1 Without prejudice to the application of any special conditions in a separate written agreement, these general conditions apply to every quotation, order confirmation, order form, sales or purchase agreement between slow wine - Footprint VOF, with registered office at Bovenstraat 76, 3770 Kanne Riemst and KBO / VAT number BE0554720927 (hereafter "slow wine") and her customer (hereafter the "Customer"). In the event of a conflict between these terms and conditions and any separate written agreement, the written agreement will prevail.
- 1.2 These general terms and conditions by the mere fact of the order or assignment placed by him. The acceptance implies that the Customer completely waives the application of its own general terms and conditions so that they are not opposed to slow wine.

- 1.3 If a provision of these general terms and conditions is unenforceable or contrary to mandatory law, this will not affect the validity and enforceability of the other provisions of these general terms and conditions. In such a case, the disputed provision is replaced by an enforceable and legally valid provision that is as close as possible to the purpose of the original provision.
- 2. Establishment of agreements**
- 2.1 All price lists, quotations and contract proposals from slow wine are without obligation, are for information purposes only and do not bind it as such. Unless otherwise dictated by law, every order placed personally by the Customer via the website www.slow-wine.net, mail, telephone or social media, connects the Customer, but slow wine only after written confirmation or acceptance thereof.
- 2.2 If the order confirmation from slow wine contains any change or addition or differs from the original order in any way, the agreement is considered closed, unless the Customer declares that he does not agree with it within 8 days after receiving the order confirmation.
- 2.3 Any cancellation of an order must be in writing and is only valid if written acceptance by slow wine.
- 3. Description of the goods and services to be supplied**
- 3.1 A description of the goods and services to be supplied is included in a separate order confirmation and / or agreement between slow wine and the Customer.
- 3.2 Without prejudice to the provisions of these general terms and conditions, the Customer acknowledges and accepts the technical limitations, warranty limitations and / or any other comments and reservations included in the quotation, order confirmation and / or any separate agreement between slow wine and the Customer.
- 4. Prices and payment**
- 4.1 The goods and services are invoiced at the prices and conditions as stated on the order form. Unless explicitly agreed otherwise, the prices stated by slow wine are exclusive of taxes, VAT, packaging costs, transport and insurance costs, which are entirely at the expense of the Customer.
- 4.2 Changes made by the Customer after the initial order will only be implemented if (i) slow wine explicitly agrees; and (ii) the Customer accepts that slow wine can fully pass on all additional price adjustments and costs to the Customer.
- 4.3 Invoices must be protested in writing within 8 days after the invoice has been sent, failing which the invoices are considered to be definitively accepted.
- 4.4 Unless stipulated otherwise, the slow wine invoice is payable in cash and net at its registered office no later than 30 days after the invoice date in the currency specified in the invoice.
- 4.5 In the event of total or partial non-payment of an invoice on the due date, the Customer is legally and without prior notice of default, interest on late payment of the unpaid invoice amount at a rate of 10% per annum, as well as a lump sum of 10% of the unpaid invoice amount, without prejudice to the right to claim higher compensation, provided evidence of higher damage actually suffered.

4.6 In the event of total or partial non-payment of an invoice on the due date, all other outstanding claims on the Customer become legally and without prior notice of default. In that case, slow wine also reserves the right to suspend the execution of the current agreement, without prior notice of default and without compensation, until slow wine has received full payment (incl. Interest and costs).

4.7 If slow wine has doubts at any time regarding the creditworthiness of the Customer, slow wine expressly reserves the right to demand a prior payment for deliveries to be made or to request (other) securities.

5. Delivery

5.1 Unless mandatory law to the contrary or express and written agreement to the contrary is provided, the date of delivery is only provided as information and is therefore not binding and delays in delivery may not give rise to a fine, compensation or cancellation of the order.

5.2 Delivery takes place in accordance with the agreed place of delivery and rates.

6. Inspection, complaints and warranty

6.1 The Customer undertakes to receive the delivered goods immediately upon delivery and to examine whether the quality thereof corresponds to what was agreed. By accepting the delivery of the ordered goods, the Customer confirms that the delivery is complete, in accordance with the order confirmation, and all visible defects are covered.

6.2 Complaints regarding the quantity and / or non-conformity must be reported to slow wine immediately upon delivery (in the case of visible defects) or at the latest within 7 days (in the case of hidden defects) per registered shipment and with indication of relevant data (including order and invoice number), failing which slow-wine may consider any complaint to be inadmissible.

6.3 Unless otherwise provided for by mandatory law or by a different arrangement, complaints must in any event be communicated within 12 months of the date of delivery.

6.4 Slow wine will not be responsible for any loss of quality that would have been caused by causes inherent in the nature of the product (including, but not limited to, normal aging). Complaints regarding possible cork flavor are always accepted by slow wine.

6.5 The guarantee granted will lapse if a loss of quality and damage is the result of incorrect treatment or misuse of the products by the Customer.

6.6 Unless otherwise dictated by law, the guarantee of slow wine is only that goods that are recognized as non-conforming are, at the option of slow wine, replaced free of charge by identical or at least equivalent goods. If the defective product is no longer in stock, slow wine may opt to provide the Customer with an equivalent of the defective product (eg a wine of a more recent volume); or (2) return of the defective product, with credit to the Customer. The application of the guarantee can in no case give rise to any form of compensation.

7. Liability

- 7.1 If slow wine (including its employees) were to be liable towards the Customer for whatever reason, slow wine is only liable for the (material and physical) damage caused (i) by the defectiveness of the goods delivered by it or (ii) as a result of the performance of the agreement, if and insofar as that damage was caused by its gross or intentional error or its fraud. Slow wine is not liable for other errors.
- 7.2 In the event that slow wine is held liable for any damage, the liability of slow wine is limited to the invoice value of the assignment from the Customer, at least to that part of the order to which the liability relates.
- 7.3 Slow wine is only liable for direct damage and never for indirect damage (including but not limited to consequential damage, lost sales, sales or profit, missed savings, unsaleability of goods and damage to third parties).
- 7.4 The Client indemnifies slow wine against any claims from third parties that suffer damage in connection with the execution of the agreement and whose cause is not attributable to slow wine.
- 7.5 In the event of force majeure, slow wine will not be liable towards the Client and slow wine will not owe any compensation. The contractual obligations of slow wine are suspended until the case of force majeure ceases to exist. If the case of force majeure continues for five working days or more, slow wine and the Customer are entitled to terminate the agreement without compensation. Force majeure is considered to be any circumstance that would hinder the execution or delivery by slow wine and over which the company has no control.

8. Retention of title

All goods remain the full property of slow wine until full payment of all invoice amounts, including costs, interest and compensation.

9. Dissolution

- 9.1 Slow wine has the right to terminate the agreement with the Customer at any time, with immediate effect, without judicial authorization or prior notice of default and without payment of any compensation, in the following cases: (i) if the Customer, despite written notice of default, fails to meet (timely and proper) compliance with one or more obligations arising from the agreement (in particular the payment of invoices); (ii) in the event of a suspension of payment or (the application for) a bankruptcy or WCO procedure by the Customer; (iii) in the event of liquidation or termination of the Customer's activities; (iv) if the Client refuses to make a prior payment or provides other securities requested by slow wine; or (v) if slow wine has good reason to doubt that the Customer will fulfill his obligations towards slow wine.
- 9.2 In the event of dissolution, slow wine is also entitled to compensation of 10% of the invoice amount as compensation for the costs, interest, loss of profit and damage suffered by slow wine, without prejudice to slow wine's right to claim compensation for any higher damage, and all claims of slow wine on the Customer become immediately due.

10. Personal information

- 10.1 The Customer gives slow wine permission to include the personal data provided by the Customer in an automated data file. This data will be used in the administration and for news mailings from slow wine. The Client also gives slow wine permission to transfer this data to the accountant for the handling of the accounting.
- 10.2 The Customer can always request a change to his data. If the Customer no longer wishes to receive mailings from slow wine, slow wine will receive a message from the Customer.

11. Applicable law and competent court

- 11.1 All agreements to which these general terms and conditions apply are exclusively governed by Belgian law.
- 11.2 Unless otherwise dictated by law, all disputes between parties concerning agreements that are subject to these general terms and conditions fall exclusively under the jurisdiction of the courts of Belgium.
